In this race (the Sid Dillon Road Race for short) racers will discover that Nebraska is not as flat as they thought. This course has plenty of hills and an exciting uphill finish.

This is the third and final event of the Nebraska Omnium Weekend, which is Stage 3 of the Midwest Flyover Series, offering \$20,000 plus merchandise in prizes. All registered racers are also eligible to enter a drawing for a free set of Williams System 30 wheels, to be awarded at Sunday's Road race. The winner will be drawn at the start of the road race. You must be present to win. Check out the Williams wheels at their tent at all three races of the Nebraska Omnium Weekend.

**REGISTRATION IS ONLINE ONLY AT <http://www.usacycling.org>. It is fast and secure. Online registration for the road race closes at 6 pm Saturday June 8, 2013.** (Juniors: you will need to print out a waiver and have it signed by a parent).

**NO DAY-OF-EVENT REGISTRATION:** In order to avoid start list and officiating confusion, the organizers have decided to discontinue day-of registration.

- The entry fee includes USAC registration fees and chip rental.
- Riders must have a USAC annual license OR purchase a 1-day license through [www.USACycling.org](http://www.USACycling.org).
- State championships are only for annual license holders who are residents of Nebraska.
- Use your number from the previous events. Put the number on the left side. Line up in the staging area 15 minutes before your event to allow for roll call and instructions.
- If this is your only event pick up your packet prior to the race; allow sufficient time prior to your race packet.
- Because the Nebraska Omnium Weekend involves two clubs it is necessary to register for each omnium event separately. There is no option to register for all three at once.
- Registration for just one or two events of the Nebraska Omnium Weekend is permitted; omnium points will be awarded to all racers as described below.

#### **GENERAL RACE RULES & INFORMATION**

- All 2013 USAC rules are in effect.
- Events will be held rain or shine.
- Place race numbers on the left side.
- Helmets must be worn at all times while on the bike.
- All riders must present a current Nebraska driver's license or equivalent to be eligible for Nebraska State Championship awards.
- Race organizers reserve the right to cancel/combine events or pay out to only the top half of a field in the event of low rider turnout.
- Held under USAC Permit 2013-1808.
- Neutral wheel support will be "wheels in/wheels out." Please make sure to identify your wheels properly. The promoter is not responsible for lost or stolen wheels. Please share wheels with teammates as there is limited space for wheels.
- The yellow line rule will be vigorously enforced, except that the course will open to two full lanes for the last 500 meters to allow for unrestricted sprinting.
- Junior gear restrictions will be strictly enforced (as specified in the USAC 2013 Rulebook). All junior riders will be subject to a rollout immediately following their competition.
- Race result protests must be filed within fifteen minutes of a result posting. Race incident reports must be filed with a race official within fifteen minutes of the finish of a race. Race organizers will make every attempt to distribute prizes the day of the race within an hour of posting final results. In the event a rider does not claim a prize within one month of the event, the prize will be forfeited.
- All races will begin promptly as scheduled and will be conducted regardless of weather conditions, unless the officials and race organizers agree to modify and/or cancel a race due to extraordinary circumstances or potentially dangerous weather or road conditions.
- Points will be awarded at all events for the **Nebraska Rider of the Year (ROY) series**. There is no Masters category for the TT or RR. The Nebraska Cycling Association is responsible for calculating points after the conclusion of the weekend. ROY points will not be calculated by the organizers during the event. - **RACE SUPPORT:** No personal or team support vehicles will be permitted on the course. Neutral wheel support may be provided in the road race on a “wheels in, wheels out” basis. Wheels should be clearly marked with rider name and race number. All riders must submit wheels to the drop off site at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the first race. Wheels should be reclaimed within 30 minutes of the conclusion of each race.

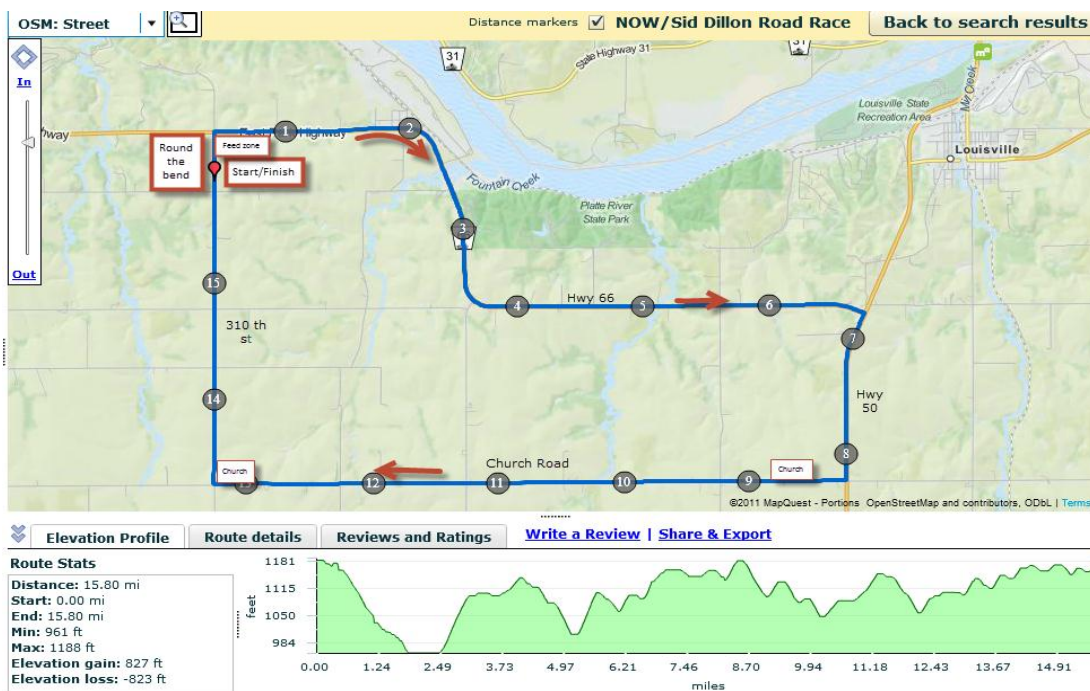
### COURSE DETAILS

Each race group will stage at Kimball Drive, just south of the finish line. There will be a very short neutral rollout to Highway 66 and racing will begin on the descent to South Bend. Riders will proceed east on Highway 66 (East Park Road) through the village of South Bend, up four long hills to highway 50 where they turn south for 1.3 miles, then west on Church Rd. The course continues west on Church Rd. to 310<sup>th</sup> St. Racers will turn north onto 310<sup>th</sup> St. and ride to Hwy 66 to make a 15.8 mile loop. The **finish line will be about 500 meters from the turn onto Highway 66, at the highest point of the course.** This will be an uphill finishing sprint. The full road will be available for the last 500 meters. After finishing, riders should quickly move off the road surface to allow other groups to continue their race. After you have finished your race, you can stay at the finish line to support other racers on the course. Prizes and awards will be distributed in the parking lot at Round the Bend.

There will be one official feed zone just past the finish line directly across from Round the Bend. Hand-ups will be from the right hand side of the road only. Neutral water will be provided and personal or team hand-ups are also allowed within the feed zone. Hand ups outside the official feed zone are not permitted. Racers are asked to not attack in the feed zone.

There are two churches on Church Road; services finish at 11:30 so most of the people will be gone by the time we go through. Be respectful and courteous to any lingering church traffic. We will not be having a feed zone at the white church at 310<sup>th</sup> and Church Road like we did in past years.

**Directions to the course:** take I-80 to exit 426 (Ashland/South Bend), drive east on Highway 66 2 miles until the top of the hill with three flags, at Round the Bend Steakhouse. Round the Bend is closed on Sundays. There are no gas stations or restaurants in South Bend or nearby, but we will have water and concessions available in the parking lot.





## Sid Dillon Time Trial Ashland Criterium Sid Dillon Road Race

An **omnium** is a set of races in which riders compete for points in each event and final placings are determined by total points in all events. Riders will receive points for their finishing placing in each of the individual races as listed below. All riders placing 16<sup>th</sup> and lower but still finishing the race will receive 1pt. The riders with the highest cumulative points at the end of the Nebraska Omnium Weekend will be awarded the cash payout and medals. Overall ties will be broken by the placing in the road race (the last race of the weekend). This points schedule applies to all three events.
